



Bed Bug Treatment Preparation Checklist

CHECK LIST:

- ___ Strip the bed(s) and launder all sheets, pillows/ pillowcases, mattress pads and blankets.
- ___ Remove clothing from dresser drawers, nightstands or dressing tables and place in plastic bags or totes. The Bags and totes are for transportation and will help prevent bugs dropping off during the trip to the laundry. DO NOT RE-USE THE BAGS. Totes should be wiped out before clean clothes are put back in.
- ___ Have all soiled clothing and linens laundered or dry- cleaned. Clean items need only to be dried for **30 minutes on HIGH heat, Do not overload.**
- ___ Discard unused cardboard boxes, shoeboxes, paper or plastic bags, old newspapers, stacks of magazines, and similar items in all potentially infested rooms. Keepsakes can be inspected separately as needed.
- ___ Vacuum all infested rooms, including the floor, closets. Vacuum bags should be placed in a sealed plastic bag and discarded.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Discarding of any compromised (ripped/ torn) materials or heavily infested items may be required.
- Do Not Move Furniture!** Dismantling of bed frames and other items will be performed as part of the service. If these items are in disrepair, we are not responsible to fix them.
- Already clean items only need dried. A HOT dryer must be used! Usually, the “timed dry setting is full heat!
- A clutter-free environment must be provided in order to allow access for the service Technician to treat all of the needed areas.
